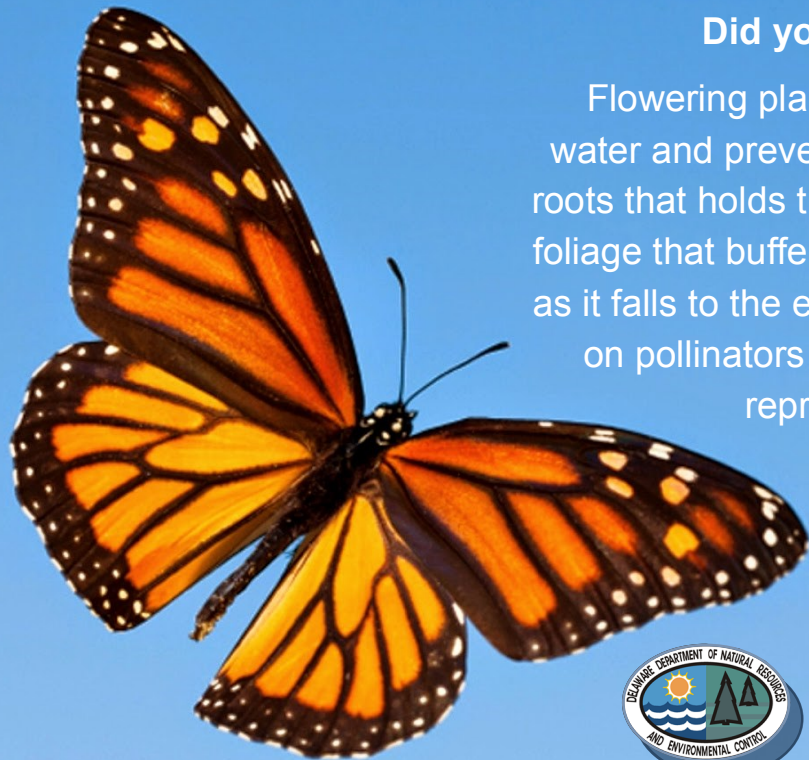
**Saving the Monarch Presentation**

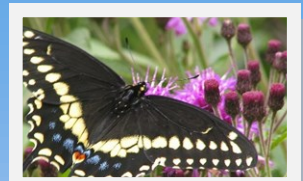
### Did you know?
