Location: Nanticoke River Public Marine Park, 26 S. Market Street, Blades, DE



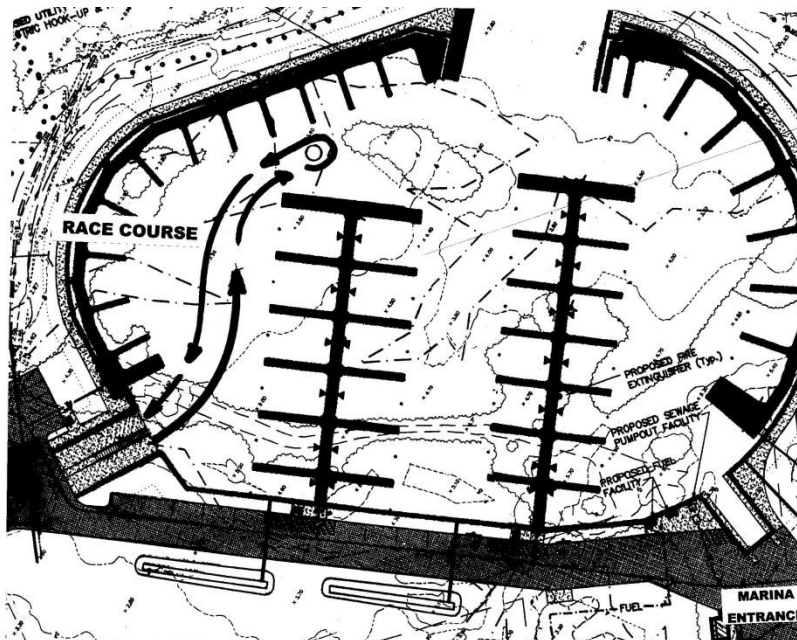
Theme: “Reclaim Our River”
